

NEVADA GIRLS STATE
ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 1

Memorializes the 2013 session of the Nevada Legislature to enact legislation that will prevent the misuse of government assistance by requiring all persons to involve themselves in voluntary drug testing to acquire social services assistance in subjects such as: foods stamps, welfare benefits, unemployment benefits, etc...

WHEREAS; Some recipients are using state money to further their addictions; and

WHEREAS; Some recipients are getting benefits to take care of their medical finances caused by said addictions; and

WHEREAS; Thus keeping people from being employed in any job; and

WHEREAS; Recipients are required to be U.S. citizens, the parent of a minor child who is a U.S. citizen, or are legal residents of the U.S.; and

WHEREAS; The state-funded money should be used to help families take care of expenses that the families are unable to handle; and

WHEREAS; Tax money could be used more efficiently by using the money as intended; and

WHEREAS; Each person will be required to be subject to random drug testing and must bring his or her prescriptions to the test; and

WHEREAS; This option will be more cost-effective for the state because our money will be better allocated by ensuring the fact that the money will not be put towards frivolous means; and

WHEREAS; It could be helpful in so many ways; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED BY THE GIRLS STATE OF NEVADA, assembled in Carson City on July 1, 2011, that the 2013 Session of the Nevada Legislature is hereby memorialized to enact legislation, which will provide the state with more money and ensure that there are not as many drug problems by drug testing all potential recipients of state-funded money.
