

NEVADA GIRLS STATE  
ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 11

Memorializes the 2013 session of the Nevada Legislature to enact legislation that will create new effective programs to help homeless revitalize themselves back into society.

WHEREAS; There are currently 13,338 of homeless people in Clark County; and

WHEREAS; 16 shelters in Las Vegas provide basic needs; and

WHEREAS; Each county in Las Vegas offers to help the homeless but lacks initiation beyond essential needs; and

WHEREAS; Establishing a program to provide vocational training to currently homeless individuals will allow them to seek employment; and

WHEREAS; The number of homeless will be decreased when gainful employment can be achieved; and

WHEREAS; Having more employment and fewer homeless is both beneficial for the economy as well as for the community; therefore be it

RESOLVED BY THE GIRL STATE OF NEVADA, assembled in Carson City July, 2013 that the 2013 Session of the Nevada legislature is hereby memorialized to enact legislation to advocate to pass vocational training which will allow homeless dependents to obtain blue collar jobs. All laws conflicting with this one are now consider null and void.
