

NEVADA GIRLS STATE  
ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 2

Memorializes the 2013 Session of the Nevada legislature to enact legislation to use renewable energy sources such as solar and wind power in order to increase Nevada's self-reliance and to provide more in-state occupations.

WHEREAS; The state of Nevada does not have any energy resources, and thus has to import natural materials such as coal, and other natural gasses from a different state; and

WHEREAS; Nevada spends close to a billion dollars to import nonrenewable energy resources into the state and to create jobs for other states; and

WHEREAS; Nevada is currently losing jobs, and is sending jobs to other states; and

WHEREAS; The recession in Nevada and job decreases has still yet to recover, the state is giving opportunities to other areas, when Nevada's economy and job situation have still not improved; and

WHEREAS; The federal government only offers programs such as nuclear energy generation and oil pipelines, which bring no benefits toward Nevada's renewable energy resources; and

WHEREAS; Using solar and wind energy to supplement coal energy purchased for outside sources make Nevada a self-reliant entity; and

WHEREAS; Expenses would be provided by decreasing limits on excessive water and energy consumption; and

WHEREAS; Solar and wind energy would decrease the amount of harmful bi-products in the environment; and

WHEREAS; Construction of solar and wind energy farms would create jobs within Nevada; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED BY THE GIRLS STATE OF NEVADA, assembled in Carson City on July 6, 2012, that the 2013 Session of the Nevada Legislature is hereby memorialized to enact legislation to use renewable energy sources such as solar and wind power in order to increase Nevada's self-reliance and provide more in-state occupations.
