

NEVADA GIRLS STATE
ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 2

Memorializes the 2015 session of the Nevada Legislature on enact legislation to legalize physician assisted death in order to end their pain.

WHEREAS; People are living in pain due to terminal illnesses such as cancers, leukemia, heart disease, etc.; and

WHEREAS; Four states have already legalized this right (Oregon, Vermont, Washington, and Montana); and

WHEREAS; People choosing to die when you have an incurable disease should be given the respect and dignity they deserve; and

WHEREAS; Doctors who are licensed and willing would be able to give the ill a peaceful death by administering a lethal dose of a painless medication; and

WHEREAS; This will be overseen by the Health and Human Services Department of the Nevada government; and

WHEREAS; There will be a \$100,000 fine, half of which will go to the government and half will go to the family of the victim, and a first degree murder charge for abuse of this law; and

WHEREAS; All laws conflicting with this resolution are now considered null and void: now, therefore be it

RESOLVED BY THE GIRLS STATE OF NEVADA, assembled in Carson City on July 5, 2013, that the 2015 session of the Nevada Legislature is hereby memorialized to enact legislation to legalize physician assisted death.
