

NEVADA GIRLS STATE  
ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 3

Memorializes the 2015 session of the Nevada Legislative to enact legislation that will create equal pay for equal work for women by requiring increases in wages to bring women's earnings into parity with those of men.

WHEREAS, At present, women make 77 cents for every dollar a man does; and

WHEREAS, That money will accumulate overtime and will circle back into the economy and support consumerism; and

WHEREAS, It prevents large corporation greed and helps support communities; and

WHEREAS, Past legislation either expired or didn't pass and in present we need equal pay for women to be equal; and

WHEREAS, Equal pay between genders in sports and high profile jobs is also important to support interest in pursuing a woman's dream in those positions by saying the work she does is just as good. For example unknown female boxers earn about \$200 to \$400 in comparison to \$2,000 to \$5,000 that unknown male boxers make per match; therefore, be it
