

NEVADA GIRLS STATE
ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 4

Memorializes the 2013 session of the Nevada Legislature to enact legislation that will raise the minimum penalty for child pornography (Gnutella) in the State of Nevada.

WHEREAS; The youth is being dragged into this addicting crime. The earliest age for a child to view pornography is 11; and

WHEREAS; There are over 116,000 request for child pornography every day; and

WHEREAS; The number of websites offering illegal child pornography is 100,000; and

WHEREAS; 1 out of 7 children report being solicited or offered for solicitation of them for sex on the internet; and

WHEREAS; It suggests that rape of children is fun and okay in the communal eye; and

WHEREAS; It suggests that masochism and sadomasochism is a walk in the park; and

WHEREAS; This behavior is modeled for all to see; men and women go out and rape children; and

WHEREAS; According to the Charles Keating of Citizens for Decency through law, research reveals that 77% of child molesters of boys and 87% of molesters of girls admitted to imitating the sexual behavior they had seen modeled in child pornography; and

WHEREAS; Pornography changes attitudes about sex; making men more aggressive towards women and children; and

WHEREAS; Rape is found to be the highest in states which have the highest sales of pornographic magazines. 70% of all magazines fall into a child's hands; and

WHEREAS; Nevada is the top pornographic video producing state because we produce: Vivid Entertainment, Hustler, Playboy, Wicked Pictures, and the Red Light District; and

WHEREAS; Raising the minimum mandatory sentence for these convicted of child pornography crimes to 8 years to life in prison and implementing a morality management course during their sentence will change the attitude and behavior of these offenders; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED BY THE GIRLS STATE OF NEVADA assembled in Carson City on July 6, 2012, that the 2013 Session of the Nevada Legislature is hereby memorialized to enact legislation that will raise the minimum mandatory sentence for those convicted of child pornography offenses and implement morality management courses during a sentence.
