

NEVADA GIRLS STATE
ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 4

Memorializes the 2017 session of Nevada Girls to enact legislation that will require high school teachers to educate their students of information that will be beneficial to them in their life after high school by incorporating these lessons into their course curriculum(s).

WHEREAS, Many students choose to not attend any form of higher education beyond high school; and

WHEREAS, Many students choose to drop out of high school, or school in general, before getting the opportunity to attend college; and

WHEREAS, Due to these decisions, these students are completely unaware of how to become useful and productive members of society; and

WHEREAS, Undergoing this program could potentially lower the amount of drug abuse among recently-graduated citizens; and

WHEREAS, This potential is due to the consideration that they will be taught about how to effectively be members of society; and

WHEREAS, New courses will not be required to be created within the curriculum; and

WHEREAS, Instead these lessons will simply be implemented within already existing courses such as math and English; and

WHEREAS, Lessons about taxes and smart financial decisions will be incorporated into math and lessons about how to write a resume will be incorporated into English; therefore be it
