

NEVADA GIRLS STATE
ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 5

Memorializes the 2015 session of the Nevada Legislature to enact legislation that will raise the taxes on the casino industry to seven (7) percent in order to help increase the education budget so that the students in the State of Nevada will receive a more advanced education.

WHEREAS, Currently, Nevada's education system is the worst in the nation; and

WHEREAS, Nevada's students have the worst chance in the nation to become academically successful; and

WHEREAS, Schools would have the ability to provide their students with the tools needed to give the students a chance at success if they had more funding; and

WHEREAS, The funding would bring in teachers who are more qualified; and

WHEREAS, Nevada's casino industry currently pays a lower tax rate than anywhere else in the country; and

WHEREAS, Our next generation is surrendering their education so casinos can bring in more profits; and

WHEREAS, The casino industries in other states have higher taxes and the education systems in those states are flourishing; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED BY THE GIRLS STATE OF NEVADA, assembled in Carson City on July 3, 2014, that the 2015 session of the Nevada Legislature is hereby memorialized to enact legislation to raise the amount of gaming taxes to seven percent so that Nevada's education system would receive more funding.
