

NEVADA GIRLS STATE
ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 6

Memorializes the 2015 session of the Nevada Legislature to enact legislation that will require the state waste management programs to use single-stream recycling.

WHEREAS; Using single-stream recycling will benefit the environment; and
