

NEVADA GIRLS STATE
ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 8

Memorializes the 2013 session of the Nevada Legislature to enact legislation that will enable public schools to use video recording cameras in each individual classroom to ensure the quality and efficiency of the staff, administration, and students.

WHEREAS, this will improve the accuracy of the evaluations of the staff; and

WHEREAS, it will increase the safety of students, especially in case of an incident; and

WHEREAS, it will increase honesty and respect of the students and staff; and

WHEREAS, the administration can properly see the students who disrupt the classrooms and can accurately punish those particular students; and

WHEREAS, states that have already enacted similar legislation have had very successful results; therefore be it RESOLVED BY THE GIRLS STATE OF NEVADA, assembled in Carson City July 1, 2011, that the 2013 session of the Nevada Legislature is hereby memorialized to enact legislation that will enable public schools to use video recording cameras in each individual classroom to ensure the quality and efficiency of the staff, administration, and students.
