

NEVADA GIRLS STATE
ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 9

Memorializes the 2013 session of the Nevada Legislature to enact legislation that will allow more teachers to keep their jobs and for students to continuously have twenty to twenty five students per class.

WHEREAS; without teachers, classes will increase in size and there will be less attention to students who need it; and

WHEREAS; teachers are the base of learning, and education is the base of our future; and

WHEREAS; with more students the teacher will lose patience more often and will not treat each student equally; and

WHEREAS; approximately 1,300 teachers are being laid off, and now professors are required furlough, there are less teachers willing to work for schools; and

WHEREAS; students and parents interests in schooling will slowly decrease because of lack of interest from their own teachers; and

WHEREAS; states that have already enacted similar legislation have had very successful results; therefore, be it RESOLVED BY THE GIRLS STATE OF NEVADA, assembled in Carson City on July 1, 2011, that the 2013 session of the Nevada Legislature is hereby memorialized to enact legislation to allow teachers to keep their jobs and for students to continuously have twenty to twenty five students per class.
