

NEVADA GIRLS STATE
SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 6

Memorializes the 2015 session of the Nevada Legislature to enact legislation that will legalize the use, selling, and taxation of recreational marijuana.

WHEREAS, Issuing an excise on cannabis would aid economic growth in the state of Nevada; and

WHEREAS, The growth and distribution of marijuana would create jobs in farming, transportation, and processing plants; and

WHEREAS, Legalization of marijuana will boost economic well-being; and

WHEREAS, A decrease in inmate population will lower tax payer spending; and

WHEREAS, The state of Nevada allows the consumption of alcohol which has many more detrimental effects than marijuana; and

WHEREAS, The legalization of marijuana will aid in the prevention of health issues such as glaucoma; and

WHEREAS, The usage of cannabis will provide help in control of epileptic seizures, decrease anxiety, and progression of Alzheimer's Disease; therefore, be it
