Transportation Information

Fill out the travel form in the waivers packet for all delegates. Read the instructions for the travel itinerary below as it pertains to everyone at some point. Please know that all times are approximate. The suggested times are meant to get you there early so that you will wait for the bus instead of the bus waiting on you. Times may change depending on the need for more or less stops. The staff on the buses will do their best to keep you informed of any changes.

Sunday, June 26, 2016

- 7:00 A.M.--buses arrive to pick up passengers at the American Legion Post 40, located at 425 E. Van Wagenen St., in Henderson, Nevada.
- Depart at 7:30 A.M.
- There may be stops in Indian Springs, US 95 and Pahrump Valley Road, Beatty, Tonopah, Silver Springs, and Carson City to pick up delegates. You will be asked on the Transportation Form to specify where you will be picked up.
 - Indian Springs pick-up will be at the Indian Springs Casino. Delegates should arrive there about **8:00am**
 - US 95 and Pahrump Valley Rd. (NV 160) pick up will be on the southeast corner lot. Delegates should arrive there about **8:20am**
 - Beatty pick-up will be at Eddie's World on the north end of town. Delegates should arrive there about **9:15am**
 - Tonopah pick up will be at the Burger King on the north end of town. This is frequently where delegates from Ely and Round Mountain can pick up the bus. Delegates will be given 45 minutes to an hour for lunch here at the Burger King/Subway/Chevron Store. Delegates being picked up here should be arrive there about **12:00pm (noon)**
 - Silver Springs pick up will be at the HWY 50 and US 95 Junction at the southeast lot. This is where delegates from Fernley, Fallon, even Winnemucca or Elko if they want, can pick up the bus. Delegates should arrive around **3:00pm**
 - Carson City pick up will be in the Kohl's parking lot, located at 3871 S. Carson St. (south of downtown, across the street from Casino Fandango), in Carson City. Buses will be on the north side of the parking lot near Jimmy Johns. This is where delegates from Reno/Sparks, Carson City, Gardnerville, Minden, and any other area can pick up the bus. Any delegates driving themselves or being driven up to camp MUST meet the buses here. Delegates should arrive there about 4:15pm
 - Again, times are APPROXIMATE. More stops along the route (US 95 from Las Vegas up through Hawthorne, to Yerington, then to Stateline, NV) may be incorporated if necessary.
 - Please remember: Any delegates driving themselves or being driven up to camp MUST meet the buses in Carson City.
- To repeat, there will be a meal stop at the Burger King/Subway/Chevron Station (these are all part of a single building) in Tonopah.
- Arrive 4-H Center approximately 5 P.M.

RETURNING:

Saturday, July 2, 2016

- Buses arrive at the 4-H Camp around 8:30 A.M. for loading for return to Las Vegas, with a projected departure time no later than 11:30 A.M.
- There will be a meal stop at American Legion and American Legion Auxiliary Mineral County 19 Post Hall in Hawthorne.
- The same stops used for the trip up will be used on the trip back. If an additional stop is required it can be arranged.
- Remaining delegates will disembark at the American Legion Post 40, located at 425 E. Van Wagenen St., in Henderson approximately 8 P.M.
- IMPORTANT!!! If someone other than a parent/guardian is picking up a delegate, the program MUST have a signed note from the parent giving permission for that person to take the delegate from the drop off point.
