

NEVADA GIRLS STATE
ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 10

Memorializes the 2017 session of the Nevada Legislature to enact legislation that will lower the dropout rates of high schools by establishing an additional college scholarship.

WHEREAS, This scholarship would be funded via the collection of a three percent tax alcohol and cigarettes sales in the State of Nevada; and

WHEREAS, The funds collected will be used as monetary incentive for students with a GPA of 2.8 and or lower; and

WHEREAS, The scholarship amount will increase depending on how successful and hardworking the eligible student is based upon the grades of the following semesters; and

WHEREAS, The scholarship eligibility shall be determined the second semester of the student's sophomore year of high school; and

WHEREAS, The eligible student becomes unable to receive the scholarship money they have accumulated if they are unable or ineligible to graduate by the end of their senior year; and

WHEREAS, The scholarship opportunity will provide a reason for staying in school and provides an opportunity to receive higher education; therefore be it

RESOLVED BY THE GIRLS STATE OF NEVADA assembled in Carson City on July 1, 2016 that the 2017 session of the Nevada Legislature is hereby memorialized to enact legislation that will lower the dropout rates of high schools by establishing an additional college scholarship.
