

NEVADA GIRLS STATE
ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 12

Memorializes the 2017 session of the Nevada legislature to enact legislation that will mandate the teaching of a second language in all public schools of Nevada in grades Kindergarten through 12th grade.

WHEREAS, If we start teaching a second, non-English language in Kindergarten and continue to teach this specific language through a child's education they are extremely likely to be bilingual by the time they graduate; and

WHEREAS, Brains are more receptive to learning multiple languages prior to 14 years of age; and

WHEREAS, Being bilingual improves cognitive skills and develops greater attention spans for younger minds; and

WHEREAS, According to Cal.org, learning a second language at a young age has a positive effect on intellectual growth and enriches and enhances a child's mental development; and

WHEREAS, Being proficient in more than one language will make Nevada students more competitive in international and global markets; therefore be it
