

NEVADA GIRLS STATE
ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 3

Memorializes the 2016 session of the Nevada Legislature to enact legislation that will require self-defense and gun safety courses for all high school students.

WHEREAS, Air-soft guns will be used to teach students how to safely handle guns; and

WHEREAS, Police officers, security guards, licensed gun dealers, military personnel, and individuals who have been honorably discharged from the armed services can be licensed to teach gun safety courses for high school students; and

WHEREAS, High schools have the choice to offer trips to gun ranges for enthusiastic students to handle real guns; and

WHEREAS, Many individuals are faced with robbery, assault, domestic violence, rape, kidnapping, and murder; and

WHEREAS, Many individuals are unaware as to how to quickly escape the previously stated situations; and

WHEREAS, Students will be required to train in hand-to-hand combat, and will learn tactics for getting out of hostile situations;

WHEREAS, approximately 900 rapes are reported per year in Nevada since 2010; and

WHEREAS, approximately 150 murders occur per year in Nevada since 2010; and

WHEREAS, approximately 42,500 larceny-thefts occur per year in Nevada since 2010; therefore be it

RESOLVED BY THE GIRLS STATE OF NEVADA assembled in Carson City on July 1, 2016 that the 2017 session of the Nevada Legislature is hereby memorialized to enact legislation that will require self-defense and gun safety courses for all high school students.
