

NEVADA GIRLS STATE
SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 1

Memorializes the 2017 session of the Nevada Legislature to enact legislation that will mandate men's public bathrooms in the State of Nevada to be equipped with a changing table.

WHEREAS, Most public men's bathrooms are not equipped with a changing table; and

WHEREAS, Any building that requires changing tables in women's bathrooms should also require changing tables in men's bathrooms; and

WHEREAS, Changing a child's diaper on a portable pad on the floor of a public bathroom is very unsanitary for all parties using this bathroom; and

WHEREAS, Changing a child's diaper without a changing table in a public setting is also very difficult/inconvenient; and

WHEREAS, With the growth of single male parents and same-sex male parents, men are changing diapers the same amount as women; and

WHEREAS, All parents, no matter the gender, should have the opportunity to take care of their children; and

WHEREAS, Male and female parents should have the same access to equipment to make changing their child's diapers more convenient in any situation; therefore be it

RESOLVED BY THE GIRLS STATE OF NEVADA assembled in Carson City on July 1, 2016 that the 2017 session of the Nevada legislature is hereby memorialized to enact legislation that will mandate men's public bathrooms in the state of Nevada be equipped with a changing table.
