

NEVADA GIRLS STATE
SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 13

Memorializes the 2017 session of the Nevada Legislature to enact legislation that will require all Nevada public schools to offer free after-school tutoring in English and Mathematics with teachers.

WHEREAS, Parents will not have to struggle to ensure that their children do not lose opportunities to understand the concept of what they are learning due to financial struggles; and

WHEREAS, High school students will not experience undue stress over the idea of having to keep up with their classmates; and

WHEREAS, Children will receive one-on-one instruction, allowing them the opportunity to explore new ways in which to learn; and

WHEREAS, Students will receive an avenue for increased communication and be able to engage in more questions; and

WHEREAS, Students will gain confidence in their expanded knowledge regarding tested content, leading to improvement in their test scores; and

WHEREAS, Students who take advantage this type of assistance make improvements in grade-level assessment scores, general class grades, and ACT/SAT scores and also receive more academic scholarships to colleges worldwide; and

WHEREAS, This resolution can be funded via the “Nevada Plan” and Distributive School Account (DSA); therefore be it
