NEVADA GIRLS STATE SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 14

Memorializes the 2017 session of the Nevada Legislature to enact legislation that will require the implementation of a minimum of four texts per year by culturally diverse authors in English and History courses.

WHEREAS, Minority students should have the opportunity to learn about their own history through the use of culturally diverse texts of the unit or various time periods, allowing for a wide array of perspectives; and

WHEREAS, Curriculum would be representative and cater towards diversity in schools; and

WHEREAS, Students would be able to learn equally about minority cultures within and outside of American cultures; and

WHEREAS, All students would have the opportunity to read texts written from people of color as well as people of minority cultures such as Scandinavian cultures, Nordic cultures, and Basque cultures among others; therefore, be it

RESOLVED BY THE GIRLS STATE OF NEVADA assembled in Carson City on July 1, 2016, that the 2017 Session of the Nevada Legislature is hereby memorialized to enact legislation that will promote educational diversity within all schools.
