

NEVADA GIRLS STATE  
SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 8

Memorializes the 2016 session of the Nevada legislature to enact legislation that will mandate the formation of a council composed of Nevada public school educators to be involved in the creation of standardized test benchmarks to ensure education reform in Nevada,

WHEREAS, Having teachers included in the process of standardized test will all for the creation of realistic, achievable, and effective benchmarks by grade level; and

WHEREAS, Each County in Nevada will nominate a number of teachers to this council based on population in order to accurately compose standardized testing benchmarks; and

WHEREAS, Nevada is ranked 50<sup>th</sup> in education nationally due to non-involvement of educators; and

WHEREAS, Teachers have the right to be involved in the establishment of the criteria on which their students are being tested; and

WHEREAS, Teachers are currently being evaluated upon the success of their students on these standardized test; therefore be it
