

NEVADA GIRLS STATE
ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 11

Memorializes the 2019 session of the Nevada legislature to enact legislation that will require all Nevada high schools to offer a series of elective courses that teach important life skills.

WHEREAS, this class would be offered progressively over four years; and

WHEREAS, this course would include the topics: high school adjustment, comprehensive sex education, home economics, financial management, professional readiness, exploring a variety of career/college paths, career/college specific research/internship opportunities, and adulthood transition; and

WHEREAS, this course will enable students to be more productive in the way of thinking and be productive adults and citizens in their communities; and

WHEREAS, some students find other courses inapplicable/irrelevant to everyday life, quite on the contrary to the purpose of this course which may increase student attendance; and

WHEREAS, this course will teach applicable life skills that some students may not receive from home; and

WHEREAS, according to *Debate.org* “81% of the surveyed users voted yes” they would want this type of class enforced in schools; therefore be it
