

NEVADA GIRLS STATE
ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 3

Memorializes the 2019 session of the Nevada Legislature to enact legislation that will establish a 50 cent per contain tax of tobacco in order to fund the expansion and improvement of public schools.

WHEREAS, there are not enough desks or classroom space to accommodate all students in public schools in the state of Nevada; and

WHEREAS, the lack of material and accommodations for these students inhibits their desire to attend school and take academics seriously; and

WHEREAS, students in Nevada do not have all the same luxuries and necessities as students in other states and therefore do not have the opportunity to acquire and equally beneficial education; and

WHEREAS, students feel the education system does not care about the students or their academic success due to the lack of supplies and accommodations; and

WHEREAS, bathrooms in some schools do not have doors to separate them from the hallways, violating the students' fourth amendment right to privacy; and

WHEREAS, multiple plumbing issues go unattended and distort the wall, ceilings, and floors of schools; therefore be it

RESOLVED BY THE GIRLS STATE OF NEVADA assembles in Carson City on June 30, 2017 that the 2019 session of Nevada legislature is hereby memorializes to enact legislation to establish an additional tax on tobacco in order to fund the expansion and improvement of public schools.
