

NEVADA GIRLS STATE
ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 5

Memorializes the 2019 session of the Nevada Legislature to enact legislation that will require Nevada to join the United States Climate Alliance in order to combat climate.

WHEREAS, Climate change has led to increased risk of wildfire, high temperatures, and agricultural damage in the state of Nevada; and

WHEREAS, Without action, climate change will continue to have adverse effects in the state; and

WHEREAS, Nevada already has strong renewable energy programs, accounting for 21.6% of total energy production in 2016; and

WHEREAS, Expanding Nevada's existing programs would fulfill the goals of the Alliance; and

WHEREAS, Expanding renewable energy in Nevada would lead to job growth and lower rates of exposure to pollutants among citizens; and

WHEREAS, The transition to renewable energy may be encouraged via a tax deduction for corporations and property owners; and

WHEREAS, Joining the United States Climate Alliance would alleviate the causes and therefore effects of climate change; therefore be it

RESOLVED BY THE GIRLS STATE OF NEVADA assembled in Carson City on June 29, 2018, that the 2019 session of the Nevada legislature is hereby memorialized to enact legislation to require Nevada to join the United States Climate Alliance in order to combat climate.
