

NEVADA GIRLS STATE
SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 10

Memorializes the 2019 session of the Nevada Legislature to enact legislation that will hire several additional liaisons or Guidance Counselors depending on the students per school in Nevada and assign each counselor approximately two hundred families with the intent of informing every family of the educational opportunities to be taken advantage of specifically in the fifth and eighth grade.

WHEREAS, School chaos is dramatically increasing per school year and pupils are not getting regular counsel, attention, and educational opportunity information that could help them through the school year; and

WHEREAS, Low income families are not able to receive the full support of the school system due to conflicting work schedules and cannot indulge themselves into their children's education, therefore, they are not aware of all of the opportunities they could be taking advantage of; and

WHEREAS, Many high school students are not aware of college opportunities/scholarships as well as the application process required for college acceptance; and

WHEREAS, Students are clueless to the schools and programs available to them in secondary and higher up education and parents are unaware of these opportunities because of a lack of communication; therefore be it

RESOLVED BY THE GIRLS STATE OF NEVADA assembled in Carson City on June 30, 2017 that the 2019 session of the Nevada legislature is hereby memorialized to enact legislation to hire several additional Guidance Counselors depending on the amount of students per school in Nevada and assign each counselor two hundred families to notify and counsel with.
