

NEVADA GIRLS STATE  
SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 16

Memorializes the 2019 session of the Nevada Legislature to enact legislation that will increase the current tax on alcohol by 2 cents per container in order to establish a fund that may be used to monetarily incentivize doctors and specialists to work in Nevada long-term.

WHEREAS, reimbursement would be given to graduate students to be used solely for student loans post contract signing; and

WHEREAS, 5% would be given for each year they practice their field within the State; and

WHEREAS, increasing the number of doctors and specialists would minimize wait times; and

WHEREAS, health problems will receive immediate attention therefore improving individuals health; and

WHEREAS, all laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void; therefore be it

RESOLVED BY THE GIRLS STATE OF NEVADA assembled in Carson City on June 30, 2017 that the 201 session of the Nevada Legislature is hereby memorialized to enact legislation to incentivize doctors and specialists to practice in Nevada long-term.
