

NEVADA GIRLS STATE  
SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 17

Memorializes the 2019 session of the Nevada Legislature to enact legislation that will require all public schools in the state of Nevada to offer High School students a complete semester of Drivers Education.

WHEREAS, The majority of parents of currently enrolled students do not have the necessary time to instruct their children of drivers safety and rules of the road; and

WHEREAS, Furthering students knowledge from the basics of traffic law and traffic signs to fundamental safety tips and pedestrian awareness will prevent more traffic accidents; and

WHEREAS, Motor vehicle crashes were the leading cause of deaths among teenagers in 2016; and

WHEREAS, Young drivers that have not taken Driver's Education are 75% more likely to get a traffic ticket, 25% more likely to be involved in a fatal or injury accident, and 16% more likely to be involved in an accident; therefore be it

RESOLVED BY THE GIRLS STATE OF NEVADA assembled in Carson City on June 30, 2017 that the 2019 session of Nevada legislature is hereby memorialized to enact legislation to require all public schools in the state of Nevada to offer High School students a complete semester of Drivers Education.
