

NEVADA GIRLS STATE  
SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 9

Memorializes the 2017 session of the Nevada Legislature to enact legislation that will institute national election day, the second Tuesday of November, to be a state holiday to incentivize Nevadans to vote for Senators and Representatives.

WHEREAS, Out of 3,323,497 (2017), 1,010,100 Nevadans voted in the 2016 election for senate which is 30.5% of the population that is eligible to vote; and

WHEREAS, Those who work in the private sector should work half the required hours to ensure an equal voting opportunity; and

WHEREAS, Early voting options will still be available for voters who chose to vote early; and

WHEREAS, High school seniors who are of legal voting age and college students will not miss class time to exercise their civic duty; therefore be it

RESOLVED BY THE GIRLS STATE OF NEVADA assembled in Carson City on June 30, 2017 that the 2019 session of the Nevada legislature is hereby memorialized to enact legislation to incentivize Nevadans to vote for Senators and Representatives.
