NEVADA GIRLS STATE ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 1

AN ACT to increase the sales tax on cigarettes by 0.1% in order to fund staff to provide students enrolled in primary and secondary schools in the state of Nevada with a standardized means of class and curriculum placement with the goal of promoting equal opportunities for all.

Section 1: This Act will allow students in the state of Nevada to receive an accurate an unbiased opinion regarding the proper level of class enrollment through using already implemented standardized testing rather than other means such as teacher recommendations.

Section 2: This Act will allow for the current means of appeal as established by each district if the student believes their class determination is inaccurate.

Section 3: Students transferring from out of state will be required to complete the respective placement test upon entry into the Nevada school system.

Section 4: In order to accomplish the evaluation involved in accomplishing this Act, districts will employ a group of 10 people to the Nevada education system whose job will be solely to ensure that these results are analyzed and used properly.

Section 6: The state of Nevada will support this bill in order to improve the school system on a larger level and enact widespread change in order to have a larger impact than a single school district would.

Section 7: This act will be effective upon passage.
