

**NEVADA GIRLS STATE
ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 5**

AN ACT that will mandate the teaching of comprehensive sex education in high school health class rather than utilizing abstinence only education.

Section 1: Teen pregnancy rates are much higher in abstinence only schools than in comprehensive sex education schools.

Section 2: Many teenagers are uncomfortable getting birth control and STD information through their parents, and some parents are also uneducated, leaving school as the only source of information.

Section 3: Inclusivity in comprehensive sex education curriculum is able to be more informational for LGBTQ+ teenagers, reducing the rate of AIDS transmission and keeping the community safe from STDs.

Section 4: In order for schools to effectively reach all students through sex education, teaching must be inclusive of all sexual relationships, levels of affection, and identities.

Section 5: This act will be effective upon passage.
