

**NEVADA GIRLS STATE
ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 7**

AN ACT that will raise the general tax on alcohol to 8.25% in order to provide court-appointed psychologists to interview children involved in custody disputes.

Section 1: Under this statute, interviews would be required for all custody cases involving a child(ren) with the ability to communicate.

Section 2: Under this statute, interviews would be required in all cases.

Section 3: Psychologists and cases workers must be present in all child interviews. In cases with children that have disabilities there must be a psychologist specialized for that child's needs.

Section 4: During the child interviews parent are not to be present.

Section 5: When interviews are standard practice judges will be more likely to take into consideration the child interviews.

Section 6: This act will be effective upon passage.
