

**NEVADA GIRLS STATE  
SENATE BILL NO. 17**

An Act that will increase funding for English as a Second Language programs including translators in schools by creating a 2% tax on alcohol sold in the state.

Section 1: Many students who do not speak English do not have access to English education outside of school.

Section 2: Many non-English speaking students are not receiving extra help to learn English.

Section 3: Students are not able to understand lessons in all subjects if they do not speak English.

Section 4: Non-English speaking students are not currently receiving adequate help in school.

Section 5: Translators are usually not available for parents who do not speak English to be able to communicate with teachers and the school to help their children.

Section 6: Students who cannot understand the teachings because of a language barrier are often failed without correcting the source of the issue.

Section 7: Non-English speaking students are often only taught basic English and not taught to their level.

Section 8: This Act will be effective upon passage.
