

**NEVADA GIRLS STATE  
SENATE BILL NO. 3**

AN ACT that will end all exemptions for vaccinations for public school students in grades K-12 except for medical reasons. Information about the safety of vaccinations should be disseminated to the public.

Section 1: The recent opposition to vaccines has become an epidemic due to many adults and parents being ill informed on the effects of vaccinations.

Section 2: Unvaccinated students pose a threat to public health in schools and communities.

Section 3: The increase of unvaccinated children could cause an outbreak of rare and highly dangerous diseases that can spread to become an even greater epidemic.

Section 4: Future generations have increased protection through vaccinations by protecting unborn children from damaging viruses, and vaccinations increase the ability to eradicate diseases for future generations.

Section 5: Vaccines are medically proven to be safe; however, those with medical exemptions such as immune deficiencies may be exempt.

Section 6: Allergic reactions from vaccinations are extremely rare.

Section 7: This act will be effective upon passage.
