

**NEVADA GIRLS STATE
SENATE BILL NO. 9**

An Act that will mandate that the state of Nevada subsidizes long-term psychiatric care for those with severe mental illness if private insurances does not cover it. Funding for this care would come through a 2% increase on sales taxes on marijuana, alcohol, and tobacco.

Section 1: More affordable, long-term psychiatric care will benefit the community by decreasing the rates of violent crimes and incarceration.

Section 2: This aid will help those with mental illness to gain soft skills and later get jobs.

Section 3: This influx of patients in mental health facilities will create new jobs.

Section 4: This Act will be effective on passage.
