

NEVADA GIRLS STATE
ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 4

Memorializes the 2015 session of the Nevada Legislature to enact legislation to supply public schools in the state of Nevada with consistent renewable energy by installing solar panels through state cooperation with local energy corporations.

WHEREAS, Nevada is a desert and has a consistent supply of sunlight; and

WHEREAS, Solar panels are a locally available source; and

WHEREAS, Solar energy is clean, silent, and there is no air pollution; and

WHEREAS, One kilowatt solar system prevents 170 pounds of coal from being burned and 300 pounds of carbon dioxide from being released into the atmosphere; and

WHEREAS, The school can potentially eliminate its monthly electric bill; and
