Packing Guidelines

The location of the camp is in a forested area and casual clothing is appropriate, **keeping in** mind that it shouldn't be too casual. Nice jeans are just fine! Speakers donate their time and talents and are all professionals, many of them in government service at the highest levels. As part of showing respect for them is being dressed appropriately, clothing such as short-shorts, cutoffs, ripped items, or t-shirts with inappropriate messages on them are not permitted!

General Clothing Guidelines

- Dress to be presentable and comfortable!
- Be sure to bring a warm jacket or sweater.
 It is usually cool in the late evenings and early mornings; at times, it has been cold!
- Slacks, skirts, dresses, and jeans are permitted. Everything should be presentable, so no rips or tatters Dresses and skirts must come to your knees
- 3 or 4 summer **shirts** and 2 or 3 long-sleeved ones We never know what the weather will be like.
- The usual **undergarments**, **socks**, etc., of course.
- Pajamas/sleeping apparel. You can bring a bathrobe if you like.
- COMFORTABLE shoes, both for camp and Carson City,
 Remember, we do a lot of walking, so Sneakers are best for camp, as there is sand and
 gravel. Foot killers would be flip-flops and high heels. Dress shoes for Carson City must
 be closed-toed

Required Clothing

- A black skirt or black slacks for our official photo
- Business attire for our Legislative Session in Carson City
 - o Dresses or skirts must come to you knees! (We suggest just going with slacks.)
 - Shoulders must be covered
 - Dress shoes must be closed-toed
 - No flip-flops

Supplies Needed

Bedding

Additional Items

- → Needed when participating in activities such as campaigns
 - 1-inch, 3-ring binder
 - Pens/Pencils
 - Small Scissors
 - Masking Tape
 - Construction Paper
 - Markers and other items to decorate posters
- → These items might be useful/helpful
 - Running/athletic clothing (If you're a runner, you'll have the opportunity to run in the mornings with a group and a staff member.)
 - Flashlight
 - A refillable water bottle
 - A small pillow that can be used as a seat cushion
 - Spending money (for our session CDs, snacks, sweatshirts, or forgotten items)
- → Talent show items (if you'd like to participate in our talent show)
 - Costume or outfit
 - Sheet music or script
 - CD or iPod
 - Musical instrument
 - We have an electronic piano.

A quick note about the talent show: If you would like to share your talent but you're shy or nervous, just take the chance and do it! You will be amazed at how supportive other delegates are when someone has the courage to stand up and share something special.
