

NEVADA GIRLS STATE
SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 6

Memorializes the 2017 session of the Nevada Legislation that will create a more involved electorate and less errors and/or problems on voting day, securing against the possibility of fraud.

WHEREAS, Republican controlled states like Nevada are making it more difficult for voter registration losing and limiting the community's interest and say in politics; and

WHEREAS, Nevada presently is not a major player on the political stage, making us more forgotten in the preliminary presidential election; and

WHEREAS, This would make us more competitive and important by bringing in candidates to come speak and boost our economic revenue from people traveling and staying in hotels, and buying merchandise; and

WHEREAS, The out-of-date registration process is plagued by two problems: paperwork and parties; and

WHEREAS, Sixty million registration applicants nationwide are filled out on paper and then transferred to a computer database creating sloppy errors; and

WHEREAS, Nevada is ranked number seven in biggest decreases in voting turn-out, an all-time low in 70 years since World War II; and

WHEREAS, The United States of America is a representative democracy, which by definition requires people to get involved and basic involvement is in fact voting; and

WHEREAS, Automatic registered voting is a world standard and places like Canada have seen a positive impact on active voting; therefore, be it

RESOLVED BY THE GIRLS STATE OF NEVADA assembled in Carson City on June 26, 2015, that the 2017 Session of the Nevada Legislature is hereby memorialized to enact legislation that will create more community involvement for electorate and secure less errors that are involved in the registration process.
