

NEVADA GIRLS STATE
ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 10

Memorializes the 2019 session of the Nevada Legislature to enact legislation that will increase the state minimum wage to comply with the Massachusetts Institute of Technology “Living Wage Calculator” by raising it to \$10.39.

WHEREAS, The current minimum wage in Nevada is \$8.25 per hour and someone working 40 hours a week on this salary would make \$17,160 per year; and

WHEREAS, A living wage for one adult is cited by the MIT living wage calculator as \$10.39 per hour, and the Nevada minimum is \$4.451.20 per year beneath that; and

WHEREAS, The Nevada minimum wage shall be subject to the annual cost of living adjustments to stay in accordance with the MIT living wage calculator; and

WHEREAS, Raising the minimum wage is not directly linked o inflammation and instead improves society by decreasing poverty and heightening worker productivity; therefore be it

RESOLVED BY THE GIRLS STATE OF NEVADA assembled in Carson City on June 30, 2017 that the 2019 session of the Nevada Legislature is hereby memorialized to enact legislation to increase the state minimum wage to comply with the Massachusetts Institute of Technology “Living Wage Calculator” by raising it to \$10.39.
