

NEVADA GIRLS STATE
SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 5

Memorializes the 2019 session of the Nevada Legislature to enact legislation that will form partnerships between Nevada school districts and local businesses to provide kids of lower socioeconomic classes with school sponsored jobs in order to reduce drop-out rates that are caused as a result of economic instability, as well as to ensure students from lower income families have an equal opportunity to graduate from high school.
