

NEVADA GIRLS STATE
SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 7

Memorializes the 2019 session of the Nevada Legislature to enact legislation that will require bathrooms in public buildings including schools to be gender neutral.

WHEREAS, many people transitioning genders still do not know how to identify themselves;
and

WHEREAS, people of genders not identifiable by male and/or female would feel safer or more secure using gender neutral bathrooms without any threat of discrimination; and

WHEREAS, despite the cost for business (or the cost for the general additional construction), citizens will feel safer and more comfortable, a luxury everyone should be able to obtain when using a bathroom; and

WHEREAS, buildings constructed or planned/designed after January 1, 2019 must have a gender neutral bathroom incorporated into the design, whereas already existing buildings would have regulated exceptions if a gender neutral bathroom can not physically fit within the existing building design; therefore be it

RESOLVED BY THE GIRLS STATE OF NEVADA assembled in Carson City on June 30, 2017 that the 2019 session of the Nevada legislature is hereby memorialized to enact legislation to require bathrooms in public buildings including schools to be gender neutral.
