

NEVADA GIRLS STATE  
SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 9

Memorializes the 2019 session of the Nevada Legislature to enact legislation that will mandate public transportation to accommodate individuals with physical, vision, and/or hearing disabilities

WHEREAS, public buses do not allow service animals to board; and

WHEREAS, individuals who have vision or hearing disabilities with service animals are dependent on these animals for mobility; and

WHEREAS, individuals who have vision or hearing disabilities with service animals are dependent on these animals for mobility; and

WHEREAS, service animals shall be allowed to perform their jobs on public transportation; and

WHEREAS, public buses currently mandate footwear, which is difficult for individuals with disabilities such as Phocomelia, which results in undeveloped limbs; and

WHEREAS, those who are not able to wear footwear shall be granted transportation regardless of footwear restrictions; therefore, be it

RESOLVED BY THE GIRLS STATE OF NEVADA assembled in Carson City on June 29, 2018 that the 2019 session of the Nevada Legislature is hereby memorialized to enact legislation that will mandate public transportation to accommodate individuals with physical, vision, and/or hearing disabilities
