

**NEVADA GIRLS STATE
ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 11**

AN ACT to increase the tax by 2% on cannabis products in order to create a juvenile rehabilitation program.

Section 1: The act will work to decrease recidivism by allowing juveniles rehabilitation within and upon release of incarceration based upon conviction.

Section 2: Juvenile delinquents will have a second chance at life, reducing the chance of them committing a future offense.

Section 3: The fourteenth and fifth amendments protect every citizen under equal protection, and every person deserves to be treated as the human they are.

Section 4: By increasing the tax on marijuana, funding will be provided for this program.

Section 5: The revenue will allow for the hiring of specialists to help support juvenile delinquents for up to three years after release. Treatment will also be provided in juvenile detention centers

Section 6: Juveniles who have been convicted of crimes are not given sufficient resources, such as a support system or mentor, to

Section 7: Requirements of specialists will include job-building assistance, school assistance, and mental health check-ups.

Section 8: Job-building includes resume building, job searching, etc.

Section 9: School assistance includes tutoring, grade checks, rides if necessary, etc.

Section 10: Mental health check-ups include a call to see how their day went, even a text to let the specialist is there for them.

Section 11: This act will be effective upon passage.
