

**NEVADA GIRLS STATE  
SENATE BILL NO. 1**

AN ACT to require all firearms handlers to pass a written or auditory test, pass a psychological evaluation, and take an in-person fifteen-hour education course in order to obtain a firearms handler's permit. provide more regulations on the usage of firearms, with the inclusion of police officers and any firearm users, carriers, sellers, and owners, by mandating a firearms handler's card to enable a safer community to be obtained through passing a required written or audio test, participating in a psychological evaluation, and taking an in person 15 hour education firearm handler's course.

Section 1: To obtain a firearm handler's card, a person would be required to take a written or auditory test and receive a minimum score of 80%. The test will be created by a qualified member of the Nevada Department of Justice. The test will consist of proper maintenance, safe usage, proper storage, safe handling, ammunition storage, and the potential risks and dangers of a firearm. The test will cost \$27.50.

Section 3: To obtain a firearm handler's card, a person will be required to pass in an initial psychological evaluation by an accredited medical professional and must pass an additional psychological evaluation every year in order to maintain a handler's license.

Section 4: To obtain a firearm handler's card, a person will be required to take a 15-hour in-person course with a trained and certified professional from the Nevada Department of Justice. This course will teach proper firearms handling, safe gun handling, home firearm safety, storage, and ammunition.

Section 5: A firearm handler's card must be renewed yearly.

Section 6: To renew a firearm handler's card, a person will be required to pay a fee of \$15.50, participate in a psychological evaluation by an accredited medical professional, and repeat the written test and obtain a score of 80% to be qualified to renew their firearm handler's card.

Section 7: Additionally, under this statute, the State sales tax for firearms will be increased by 3%. This revenue raised by this tax increase will go towards a gun safety-focused department in the police force to monitor the testing of firearm handler's permits and psychological evaluations.

Section 8: This act will be effective on passage.
