

**NEVADA GIRLS STATE
SENATE BILL NO. 2**

AN ACT that will require those who wish to obtain a Nevada medical license to complete at least 100 hours of pro-bono work in medical clinics that provide services to those unable to afford healthcare.

Section 1: Those without access to quality medical care will have the opportunity to receive medical care from qualified professionals.

Section 2: Future medical professionals will have the opportunity to practice further the skills which they will use once they obtain their license.

Section 3: Applicable establishments will be regulated by the Nevada State Medical Board and will include places such as Planned Parenthood.

Section 4: The program will not require funding as it simply concerns staffing said medical clinics, which are already functioning but require the assistance of physicians.

Section 5: This act will be effective upon passage.
