REGISTRATION will be from 5:00pm to 6:00pm, Sunday, June 21, 2020 in the Main Building at the University of Nevada, Reno's **4-H Camp**, in **Stateline**, **NV** (at **Lake Tahoe**). If you are being picked up by private transportation, advise the ones picking you up to be there by 10:30 A.M.
