

NEVADA GIRLS STATE  
ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 16

AN ACT that will prevent school districts from allowing teachers to come to school armed.

SECTION 1: A teachers first responsibility, it is not their job to respond in situations, but our security forces that get paid for it.

SECTION 2: We can not promise complete safety that comes with weapons. Teachers should not be held responsible to be ready to return fire in a situation where other people are carrying weapons and using them against teachers, staff, and students within their class.

SECTION 3: A teacher should not be held responsible to meet an armed attacker directly, force to force contact is not in their job description nor are they paid enough to do so. We have armed forces for a reason, they are paid to do the jobs teachers shouldn't have to do.

SECTION 4: Mass shootings have unfortunately become a reality in schools across America, there is no good reason to put more guns in schools.

SECTION 5: Teachers are there to educate our future generations without which police officers, fire fighters, military, etc. would not be able to do their jobs. They aren't there to be armed responders to threats that exist in schools, that could include other students.

SECTION 6: Teachers carrying guns could be dangerous for responders that are going in blindly and trying to figure out who the active shooter is. With around 60 teachers in each school, there would be mass amounts of investigation making jobs harder to conclude the criminal.

SECTION 7: Within the building, there is no distinction of teachers certified to carry guns in this public area, as opposed to active shooters causing harm to innocents inside the school.

SECTION 8: This ACT will be effective upon final message.
