

NEVADA GIRLS STATE  
ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 2

AN ACT that will expand the Nevada school district sex education curriculums to include topics such as, but not limited to: sexuality and gender identity, contraceptive use, and parental knowledge and guidance.

SECTION 1: Current Nevada sex education curriculums teach strictly male-female sexual relationships, excluding homosexual relationships thus barring homosexual youths from learning safe sex practices.

SECTION 2: Nevada state law states that sex education courses are not required to teach methods of contraception. This option restricts Nevada teenagers from learning safe sex practices and back-up contraception methods.

SECTION 3: Only half of the parents in the US have discussed healthy sexual relationships with their teenagers, 29% have talked about contraception, and only 13% have discussed sexuality and gender. This shows that teenagers receive little to no sex education in school and at home.

SECTION 4: Nevada school district sex education curriculums are strictly abstinence-based, which means it strongly encourages abstinence and discourages sexual activity. Despite this, 46% of teens living in the Las Vegas Metropolitan area are engaging in sexual activity, and doing so with very little knowledge to keep them safe.

SECTION 5: This ACT will be effective upon final passage.
