

NEVADA GIRLS STATE
ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 30

AN ACT that will require training for school staff to recognize signs and symptoms that someone else may be dealing with violence and abuse in their lives, &/or mental health issues. Also to have a child psychologist in every school to help students navigate these issues & resources.

SECTION 1: The dept of health & human services suggest that 1 in 5 child and adolescents experience a mental health problem during school years, such as bullying, stress, family problems, learning disabilities, depression, anxiety, and alcohol and substance abuse.

SECTION 2: Studies show that only 40% of students dealing with emotional, behavioral, and mental health disorders graduate from high school.

SECTION 3: Institute a 2% tax on alcohol sales to pay for the training, staff time, child psychologist in schools, & others associated with helping students in need of resources.

SECTION 4: This ACT will be effective upon final passage.
