

NEVADA GIRLS STATE
ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 31

AN ACT that will require a State compost program that allows residents to choose to compost in order to reduce waste that ends up in landfills.

SECTION 1: Pollution is a huge problem not only statewide, but globally. Having a compost system along with recycling and garbage will greatly reduce the amount of garbage that ends up in the landfill.

SECTION 2: Giving people more opportunities to dispose of leaves and other landscape waste will help remove unnecessary plants and reduce the danger of fires.

SECTION 3: Having access to compost disposal will allow for the limit of styrofoam products such as take out containers, and encourage more ecologically friendly, and easily decomposable containers.

SECTION 4: This ACT will be effective upon final passage.
