

NEVADA GIRLS STATE
ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 33

AN ACT that will amend hunting rights for Native Americans enrolled in a Nevada tribe wishing to hunt on the reservations and transport harvested game off of their reservations.

SECTION 1: Native American people should be able to transfer hunted game off of their reservation without the risk of being prosecuted.

SECTION 2: Enrolled Native Americans who live off-reservation should be able to harvest the one deer they are entitled to and bring it back to their residence.

SECTION 3: Indigenous people who live on-reservation should be able to transport game off reservation for processing.

SECTION 4: The Nevada Department of Wildlife will maintain a registry of Nevada Native Americans who declare they will be transporting a deer. Game wardens will check the database in case a stop is performed.

SECTION 5: Native Americans who harvest more than the one deer they are entitled to will be subject to Nevada's poaching laws.

SECTION 6: This ACT will be effective upon final passage.
