

NEVADA GIRLS STATE
ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 34

AN ACT that will require any business in the State of Nevada to always have working and updated cameras on their property thereby making these businesses more responsible for the safety of customers..

SECTION 1: Many businesses don't have any cameras on their property, they also don't have enough cameras around the area, or they have non-updated and non-working video.

SECTION 2: Crime rates in cities without sufficient protection against crimes, such as Las Vegas, have crime rates 55% higher than other cities that do implement the use of precautions in businesses.

SECTION 3: Many businesses, including smaller ones, are likely to have 400-600 dollars that they could use to buy a security system that would prevent the future occurrence of being charged with a negligence lawsuit from a customer whose car got broken into while in a lot without a security camera.

SECTION 4: This ACT will be effective upon final passage.
